The diverse landscapes of the Corner Country are home to many native Australian birds. Some are permanent residents, others make their homes here when there is available food or water.

Imagine the pleasure of finding a grey grass-wren amongst the lignum swamps of Sturt National Park.

Or, if you are lucky, you might see and hear wave after wave of wild budgerigars darting and weaving on their way to water.

You might wake to the sound of Major Mitchell cockatoos heading out to feed amongst the sand hill pines, and listen for them again in the evening as they return.

Such can be the experiences of a bird watching trip to the

Corner Country where accommodation on Sturt National Park or on station properties across the region will put you into the right locations.

So, start planning your next bird watching expedition now. Pack your binoculars and camera and head on out to the Corner Country.
