Looking for an interesting place to visit by air? Head out to the Corner Country where you can fly-in and taxi to the hotel, or land on a station property and be greeted by the owner. And, best of all, no landing charges!

The Corner Country of western New South Wales is quite something viewed from the air. Its rugged arid ranges form the grey back-bone of the landscape, fingers of gutters merge into snake-like creeks, long green lines of trees follow the course of long dry beds and parallel dunes of ochre red stretch far toward the horizon.

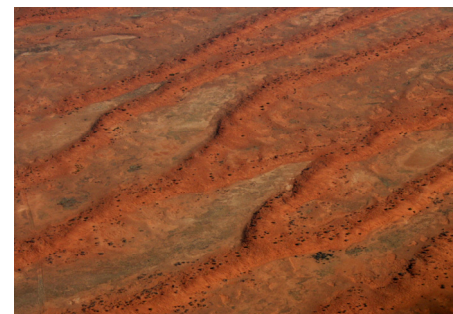
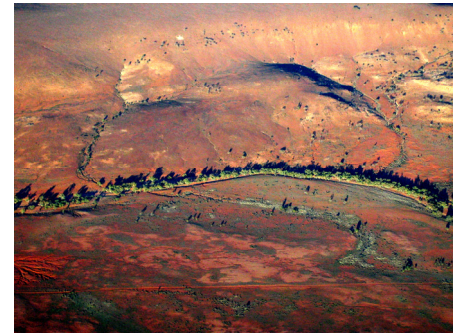
Interspersed amongst the features are the solitary signs of civilisation, a homestead here, a township on the end of a dusty road.

But, whilst the landscape may be big and "empty", the Corner Country is filled with characters

and history. To meet the locals in Milparinka just land and taxi to the hotel door, or in Packsaddle or Tibooburra arrange a pick-up from the airfield before heading to one of the pubs.

For something different there are station properties where fly-ins are welcome and pilot and passengers are always treated by station-owners to truly warm bush experience.

So, start planning your next air adventure soon. Take out your WAC charts, check out the properties, log the coordinates into the GPS and take-off for the Corner Country.
